CONSENT AND RELEASE AGREEMENT 2018-2019

The Participant identified above desires to participate (as a team member, mentor, board member, parent volunteer or in some other manner) in the Cavalier Robotics program ("Program") of Charlottesville Albemarle Robotics, a Virginia not-for-profit corporation, which utilizes space ("Premises") provided by the University of Virginia School of Engineering and Applied Science. As a condition of allowing Participant to participate in Charlottesville Albemarle Robotics, it is required that the Participant (and his or her Parent/Guardian if under 18 years of age) agree to the terms of this Consent and Release Agreement.

1. Participant (and the Parent/Guardian of a Participant under 18 years of age) (collectively "Participant") understands that participation in the Program will expose Participants to risks of injury including, without limitation, injury from: building, lifting, and using electrical/mechanical robots and robot components; using tools; and other participants, and that Participant fully assumes all risks of any personal injuries from such participation. Participant understands that Participant may decline or cease participation in any activity which Participant feels is too dangerous or for which Participant feels unqualified or improperly trained.
2. Participant understands that Participant is fully responsible for any personal property of the Participant brought onto the Premises or to any Program event and that Participant shall not store any personal property on the Premises, and that any personal property stored on the premises may be subject to theft or damage, or may be discarded by the Program or by the University of Virginia.
3. Participant understands that, although the University of Virginia provides the Premises the Program's use, the Program is not affiliated with the University of Virginia and the University of Virginia is not responsible for any aspect of the Program.
4. Participant understands that neither Charlottesville Albemarle Robotics nor University of Virginia provide transportation to any Program event and are not responsible for any car pools or injuries or property damage incurred as a result of any transportation to or from such events.
5. Charlottesville Albemarle Robotics, in its sole discretion, may terminate the participation of any Participant in the Program at any time without prior notice if it is determined to be in the best interest of the Program in the sole discretion of Charlottesville Albemarle Robotics and the Participant shall not be entitled to any refunds of any program fees paid.
6. In consideration for Charlottesville Albemarle Robotics allowing the Participant to participate in this Program, Participant (and the Parent/Guardian of a Participant under 18 years of age for and on behalf of the Participant and the Parent/Guardian) assumes all risk of such participation and hereby releases Charlottesville Albemarle Robotics, the University of Virginia, any Sponsors, and all of their respective directors, officers, sponsors, volunteers, and agents from any and all claims, liabilities or damages for any injury of any kind to the Participant (and the Parent/Guardian) or other damages to person or property that may occur as a result of the Participant's participation in the Program, including without limitation, any injuries or other damages that may be caused by the negligence of Charlottesville

Albemarle Robotics, the University of Virginia or negligence of any of Charlottesville Albemarle Robotics, University of Virginia or Sponsor directors, officers, sponsors, volunteers, or agents (including without limitation negligently failing to adequately investigate or screen coaches, mentors, volunteers, etc.), and agrees not to file any lawsuit or otherwise make any claim against Charlottesville Albemarle Robotics, the University of Virginia or any of its directors, officers, sponsors, volunteers, or agents for any such injury or other damages.

7. Participant (and the Parent/Guardian of a Participant under 18 years of age) understands that photographs, videotapes, and other recordings will be made of Participants in the Program, including the Participant. Participant (and the Parent/Guardian of a Participant under 18 years of age) consents to those photographs, videotapes, and other recordings and the use thereof (i) as part of a record of the Program and (ii) to promote Charlottesville Albemarle Robotics and the Program.

Participant (and the Parent/Guardian of a Participant under 18 years of age) has read this document and understands that this Consent and Release Agreement includes a waiver of the right to make injury claims that is intended to be legally binding. By signing below, Participant (and the Parent/Guardian of a Participant under 18 years of age) agrees to this Consent and Release Agreement.
